

# IMPROPER USE OF DRUGS AND MEDICINES- QUICK FACTS

Basketball Australia is committed to the health, safety and well-being of all Participants and dedicated to providing a safe environment for participation in basketball throughout Australia. The policy aims to provide guidelines and restrictions on the improper use of drugs and medicines in basketball.

## Who is bound by this Policy;

o This policy applies to all relevant athletes and relevant personnel

## Basketball Australia nominate Illegal Drugs Policy Officers (IDPO's) who's role is to;

- o Be responsible for the supervision and administration of this policy
- Maintain a list of education, counselling and support services
- Report potential breaches to the Integrity Unit
- Act in a discreet and confidential manner
- o Be responsible for decisions made on behalf of Basketball Australia

### Personal Responsibilities;

- o Participants must not use, possess or traffick illegal drugs
- Only employ persons who comply with AIS Sports Science Standards
- Only employ medical professionals who are registered with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency

### Prohibited Conduct;

- The policy is contravened by someone where;
  - They receive a drug related criminal conviction
  - Possess, use or administer illegal drugs
  - Traffick, distribute or supply illegal drugs
  - Relevant persons fail to comply with the directions of the Basketball Australia
    Integrity Unit or an IDPO

### Investigation and Sanctions;

- After an investigation is conducted a person may be subject to;
  - Welfare support
  - Education
  - Counselling
  - Tribunal hearings who may determine further sanctions for more serious matters
