

Domestic Officiating Fees



The below table gives members an idea of the types of fees associated with domestic officiating. Some elements may be subsidised by the association or state. Fees vary across the country depending on officiating type, inclusions, available funding, association size, etc. In some locations, government sport participation vouchers may be available.

Uniform Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Green shirt • Association level • State level 	Association or State/ Territory
Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refs - whistle and lanyard • Scorers - pens, notebook, timer • Stats - access to a laptop 	Association or retailer
Other Uniform Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refs - black shorts/pants, socks and shoes • Scorers - black pants/skirt, shoes • Jacket (competition dependent) 	Association or retailer
