Basketball Australia is committed to providing a safe, inclusive, and enjoyable environment for all participants, officials, and spectators at our National Championships.

All spectators play an important role in supporting a positive championship experience. We expect all attendees to always demonstrate the highest standards of sportsmanship and respect, both on and off the court, including during travel and within surrounding venues.

Spectators Agree To

Safety and Wellbeing of Participants

- Prioritise the physical, emotional, and psychological safety of all participants.
- Understand and uphold the values and standards that Basketball Australia has established.
- Recognise and respect the rights, identities, and dignity of all participants, regardless of age, race, gender, ability, cultural background, sexuality, or religion
- Remain in the spectator area and not access the Court or other off-limit areas.

Uphold the Integrity of Sport

- Always respect the decisions of the coaches and officials.
- Lead by example, upholding the values of fairness, respect, and integrity.
- Encourage enjoyment, effort, and participation rather than just outcomes or performance.
- Respect the decisions of officials, coaches, and administrators, modelling positive behaviour.
- Ensure a harassment-free and discrimination-free environment.

Compliance and Enforcement

- Breaches will be addressed by Basketball Australia or the Venue and may result in eviction.
